The Government has issued Notification regarding Public, Special, Restricted, Commercial and Industrial and Bank Holidays for the year 2022.

Republic Day - January 26, Holi - March 18, Gudi Padava - April 02, Birth Anniversary of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar - April 14, Good Friday - April - 15, May Day - May 01, Eid-Ul-Fitr - May 3, Id-Ul-Zuha (Bakri-Id) - July 10, Independence Day - August 15, Ganesh Chaturthi (1st Day) - August 31, Ganesh Chaturthi (2nd Day) - September 1, Gandhi Jayanti - 02 October, Dussehra (Vijaya Dashmi) - October - 05, Diwali - October -24, Feast of St. Francis Xavier - December 03, Goa Liberation Day - December 19, Christmas Day - December 25. The Holiday declared on Eid-Ul-Fitr and Eid-Ul-Zuha are subject to the appearance of the moon.

Special Holidays are as follows: Mahashivratri – March – 01, Milad-Un-Nabi or Id-e-Milad (Birthday of Prophet Md.) – October – 09. Special Holiday on Mahashivratri applied shall be necessarily sanctioned. In case where employees do not avail of the Special Holiday on the designated day, the holiday may be availed of on any working day during the calendar year 2022 only.

Special Holiday at Milad-Un-Nabi falls on Saturday as such request for Special Holiday on this day or in lieu of this does not arise. Special Holiday mentioned at Milad-Un-Nabi is subject to the appearance of the moon. Special Holidays can be prefixed or suffixed to any kind of Leave.
